In accordance with the UPF's internship regulations, the vice chancellor may **exceptionally** exempt some organisations bearing the costs of organising the internship, meaning that the university must assumes them.

- Start-ups that were constituted less than two years from the date that the agreement began to be processed.
- Organisations that are social, charitable, cultural or in the public interest.
