

Extraordinary awarding decision of Erasmus+ International call for applications for students mobility 2020 between UPF and partner universities during 2020-2021, 2021-2022 and 2022-2023 academic years

In the framework of the Erasmus+ International Credit Mobility Programme Call 2020, linked to the project 2020-1-ES01-KA107-081617,

Having reviewed and assessed the undergraduate student's applications submitted until 20th December 2022, under the call aforementioned;

Having available funds for mobility with the Mediterranean region;

And taking into consideration the proposal by the mobility coordinator, which is in compliance with the provisions of the Erasmus+ Programme,

I RESOLVE:

1. To create 2 additional grants for students mobility with Israel from the project remaining funds from the Mediterranean region.
2. To award the mobility grants to the list of UG beneficiaries below.

The scholarship rights are subject to:

- the submission of the Erasmus+ programme required documents by the beneficiaries
- beneficiary's fulfilment of the conditions during the mobility period, as it is said in the point 4 of the call guidelines.

International mobility is subject to COVID-19-related regulations and restrictions by the authorities of the sending and the receiving countries, the sending and receiving institutions, as well as the conditions set by the Erasmus programme.

3. To keep the call open offering the remaining grants (attached). New applications will be accepted and assessed according to the same [call guidelines](#) until the remaining scholarships are awarded.
