

Ninth awarding decision of Erasmus+ International call for applications for students and staff mobility 2020 between UPF and partner universities during 2020-2021, 2021-2022 and 2022-2023 academic years

In the framework of the Erasmus+ International Credit Mobility Programme Call 2020, linked to the project 2020-1-ES01-KA107-081617,

Having reviewed and assessed the new applications submitted until March 27th 2023, under the call aforementioned;

Having available funds for mobility with Asia (region 6) and the Mediterranean region (region 3) and within the frame of flexibility among countries in the same region, we open up the types of mobility and directions of flow;
