



Sixth awarding decision of Erasmus+ International call for applications for students and staff mobility 2020 between UPF and partner universities during 2020-2021, 2021-2022 and 2022-2023 academic years

In the framework of the Erasmus+ International Credit Mobility Programme Call 2020, linked to the project 2020-1-ES01-KA107-081617,

Having reviewed and assessed the new applications submitted until December 15th 2022, under the call aforementioned;

Having available funds for mobility with the Mediterranean region, and within the frame of flexibility among countries in the same region, we open up the types of mobility and directions of flow;

And taking into consideration the proposal by the Selection Committee, on 10th January 2023, which is in compliance with the provisions of the Erasmus+ Programme,
