

Fourth awarding decision of Erasmus+ International call for applications for staff mobility and incoming students between UPF and partner universities in Israel and Lebanon 2018-2020

According to the guidelines of the call aforementioned, and the internal regulations of the Pompeu Fabra University,

Concerning student mobility

Since two of the four available incoming student grants with Lebanon have been reallocated for undergraduate outgoing mobility on the Awarding decision of the 24th July 2019,

Having received one application for undergraduate incoming mobility from American University of Beirut in Lebanon, which complies with all the eligibility criteria and has been positively assessed by the Selection Committee,

Concerning staff mobility

Since there has been a drop out among the staff previously awarded with an incoming mobility grant from Lebanon and there are no candidates on the reserve list, and there are remaining funds for additional staff mobility within the project.

Since we have received one application for a teaching mobility, which complies with all the eligibility criteria and has been positively assessed by the Selection Committee,

I RESOLVE:

1. To award 2 mobility grants to the following applicants:


The scholarship rights are subject to the submission of the Erasmus+ programme required documents by the beneficiaries.
