Objectives	<p>Erasmus Mundus Design Measures should enhance the capacities of universities to modernise and internationalise their curricula and teaching practices, pool resources, and for higher education systems to develop common mechanisms related to quality assurance, accreditation and recognition of degrees and credits.</p> <p>The support is also intended to explore and exploit the opportunities offered by the European Approach for Quality Assurance of Joint Programmes. Based on the high degree of jointness/integration among the participating institutions, such integrated transnational programmes should contribute to the integration and internationalisation of the European Higher Education Area (EHEA)</p> <p>The main objective of the Erasmus Mundus Design Measures is to encourage the development of new, innovative, high-level integrated transnational study programmes at Master level.</p> <p>These projects must include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) EU Member States and third countries associated to the Programme, and/or (b) institutions from these countries, and/or (c) thematic areas underrepresented within the action (see Erasmus Mundus Catalogue) <p>It is encouraged to at least launch any accreditation/evaluation process before the end of the project, and explore the opportunities offered by the European Approach for Quality Assurance of Joint Programmes.</p>

Who can apply?	<p>Any eligible participating higher education institution established in a Programme or Partner Country can apply.</p> <p>At application stage, the beneficiary should identify the participating organisations. However, these will not take part in the signatory process of the grant agreement.</p>

Maximum Grant	60.000 EUR												
Funding Rules	<p>The support takes the form of a financial lump sum contribution to the costs directly linked to the activities necessary to set up the new Master programme, such as meetings and conferences, studies/surveys, accreditation/evaluation process, etc. The contribution can also be used to cover staff costs, travel and accommodation costs, administrative costs and sub-contracted activities, in so far as relevant for the implementation of the EMDM</p>
