



Eighth awarding decision of Erasmus+ International call for applications for students and staff mobility 2019 between UPF and partner universities

Having reviewed and assessed the application submitted until 3rd June 2022, under the call for applications for students and staff mobility between UPF and partner universities 2019 published on 17th December 2019,

And taking into consideration the proposal by the Selection Committee, on 7th June 2022, which is in compliance with the provisions of the Erasmus+ Programme,

Given that the Erasmus+ International Credit Mobility Programme Call 2019, linked to the project 2019-1-ES01-KA107-063586, is currently open for applications and there are available funds to be fulfilled until July 2022 for staff;

Given that the 2019 project has remaining funds due to the pandemic mobility cancelations and drop outs;

And according to the guidelines of the call aforementioned, and the internal regulations of the Pompeu Fabra University

I RESOLVE:

1. To award the mobility grant for **outgoing staff** to the following applicants:

- the submission of the Erasmus+ programme required documents by the beneficiaries
- beneficiaries fulfilling the conditions of being employed and having a contractual relationship with UPF or the sending institution during the mobility period.

The mobility should be carried out before 31st July 2022.

2. To keep the call open to new applications on a rolling basis until the remaining funds are awarded (offer published in the webpage). Applications will be received and assessed according to the <u>call quidelines</u> and grants awarded on an on-going basis.
