

First awarding decision of Erasmus+ International call for applications for students and staff mobility 2019 between UPF and partner universities

Having reviewed and assessed the applications submitted until 14th February 2019, for staff and PHD students, and 31st March 2019, for undergrad students, under the call for applications for students and staff mobility between UPF and partner universities 2019 published on 17th December 2019,

And taking into consideration the proposal by the Selection Committee, on 5th October 2020, which is in compliance with the provisions of the Erasmus+ Programme,

Given the global health situation caused by the Covid-19 that forced the suspension of the administrative deadlines for the call aforementioned;

Given that the project 2019-1-ES01-KA107-063586 has been extended until July 2022;

And according to the guidelines of the call aforementioned, and the internal regulations of the Pompeu Fabra University

I RESOLVE:

2. To modify the terms of the call for applications for the aforementioned call in its article 8, "*Rights and obligations of the beneficiaries*", regarding the deadline to carry out the mobility. The current right paragraph should be: "*To carry out the mobility according to the proposal and the dates committed ending **before 31st July 2022***"



3. To keep the call open to new applications on a rolling basis until the following grants are awarded:

Lebanon: 4 incoming undergrad student, 2 incoming teaching staff and 2 outgoing teaching staff
Kenya: 2 incoming PHD student, 1 outgoing PHD student and 2 outgoing staff

Applications will be received and assessed according to the [call guidelines](#), and grants awarded on an on-going basis.
