

**Extraordinary awarding decision of Erasmus+ International call for applications for students and staff mobility 2020 between UPF and partner universities during 2020-2021, 2021-2022 and 2022-2023 academic years**

In the framework of the Erasmus+ International Credit Mobility Programme Call 2020, linked to the project 2020-1-ES01-KA107-081617,

Having reviewed and assessed the applications submitted until 31<sup>st</sup> October 2022, under the call aforementioned;

Having available funds for mobility with the Mediterranean region;

And taking into consideration the proposal by the mobility coordinators, between 16<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> November 2022, which is in compliance with the provisions of the Erasmus+ Programme,

**I RESOLVE:**

1. To create 1 additional grant for students mobility with Israel from the project remaining funds from the Mediterranean region.
2. To award the mobility grants to the list of UG beneficiaries included in the Annex.

Selected candidates will be contacted by email, starting by those whose mobility starts the soonest. If a selected candidate declines the grant for whatever reason, candidates on the reserve list will be contacted, also by email, and offered a place.


The scholarship rights are subject to:
