



Fourth awarding decision of Erasmus+ International call for applications for students and staff mobility 2020 between UPF and partner universities during 2020-2021, 2021-2022 and 2022-2023 academic years

Having reviewed and assessed the applications submitted until 12th June 2022 under the call for applications for students and staff mobility between UPF and partner universities 2020 published on 15th December 2020,

Given that the Erasmus+ International Credit Mobility Programme Call 2020, linked to the project 2020-1-ES01-KA107-081617, is currently open for applications and there are available funds to be fulfilled until 31st July 2023 for staff and students;

And taking into consideration the assessment proposal by the Selection Committee, on 27th June 2022, which is in compliance with the provisions of the Erasmus+ Programme,

And according to the guidelines of the call aforementioned, and the internal regulations of the Pompeu Fabra University

I RESOLVE:

1. To award the mobility grants to the list of beneficiaries included in the Annex.

Selected candidates will be contacted by email, starting by those whose mobility starts the soonest. If a selected candidate declines the grant for whatever reason, candidates on the reserve list will be contacted, also by email, and offered a place.


The scholarship rights are subject to:

- the submission of the Erasmus+ programme required documents by the beneficiaries
- beneficiary's fulfilment of the conditions during the mobility period, as it is said in the point 4 of the call guidelines.

International mobility is subject to COVID-19-related regulations and restrictions by the authorities of the sending and the receiving countries, the sending and receiving institutions, as well as the conditions set by the Erasmus programme.

2. To keep the call open offering the remaining grants (attached). New applications will be accepted and assessed according to the same [call guidelines](#) until the remaining scholarships are awarded.
