

**Twelfth awarding decision of Erasmus+ International call for applications for students and staff mobility 2020 between UPF and partner universities during 2020-2021, 2021-2022 and 2022-2023 academic years**

In the framework of the Erasmus+ International Credit Mobility Programme Call 2020, linked to the project 2020-1-ES01-KA107-081617,

Having reviewed and assessed the new applications submitted until June 7<sup>th</sup> 2023, under the call aforementioned;
