


PIN S.c.r.l. - Educational and Scientific Services for the University of Florence

- develop a deeper awareness within universities in order to prepare their students for direct community action through digital means;
- create a suite of online tools housed within a virtual collaboration space that will help students but also social enterprises to collaborate and create joint ventures remotely;
- 3. validate the tools by incubating 12 social innovation projects with partners in six different countries .
- 4. establish a platform for virtual internships whereby students will be able to work remotely for social enterprises and community groups on specific projects
- 5. Create and promote a SEVERE network open to promote digital social innovation


