

EURSS 2022 Awarding Decision at UPF

Gathered in a virtual meeting on Thursday, April 28, the EURSS Review Board put together the assessment of the proposals received under the EURSS call 2022.

The assessment of the applications was done by each EUTOPIA partner institution internally as deemed appropriate to ensure a fair process and thorough academic review.

The EURSS Review Board shared the quality and budget allocation criteria to make sure all applications were treated with a homogenous and standardized approach.

After reviewing the applications received, and acknowledging the quality of the proposals submitted, at UPF it has been decided
