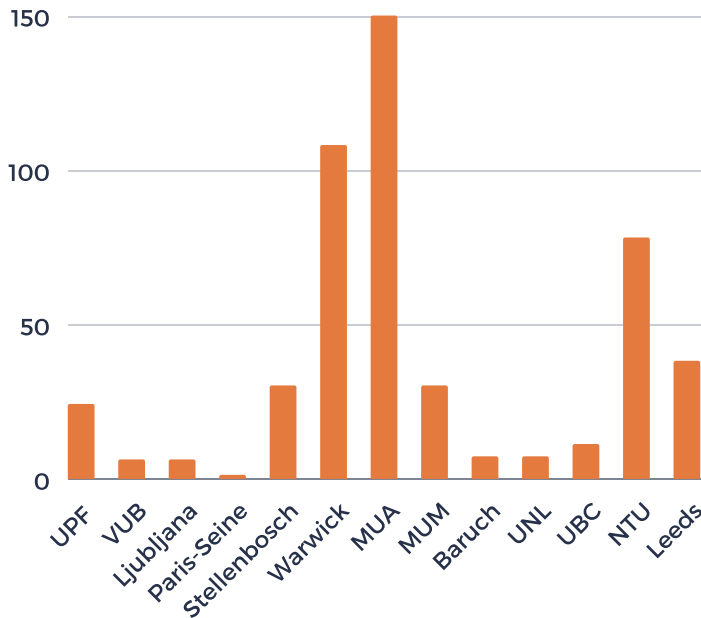


# ICUR 2020

## AT A GLANCE

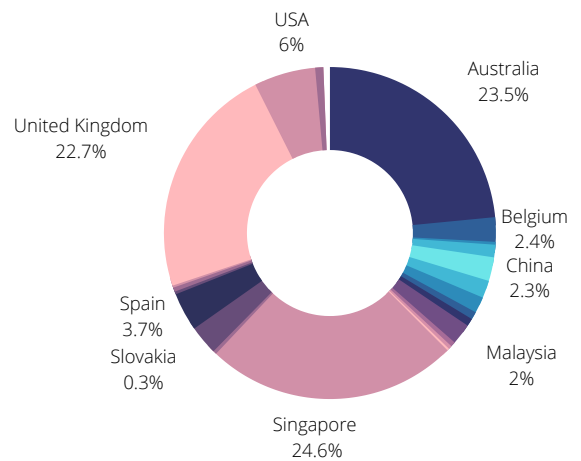


### STUDENT PRESENTERS

In 2020, 547 students presented across 109 internationally linked webinar sessions. This represents a 54% increase over 2019. Students from 13 institutions located on 5 continents presented their undergraduate research work.

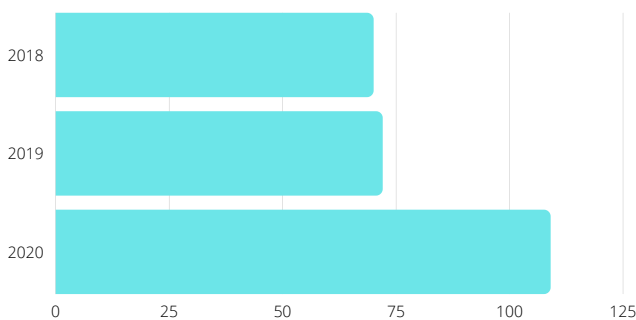
People from 40 countries registered with the ICUR App to view our presentation sessions, with 2516 registered app users in total and an average of 23 audience members per session.

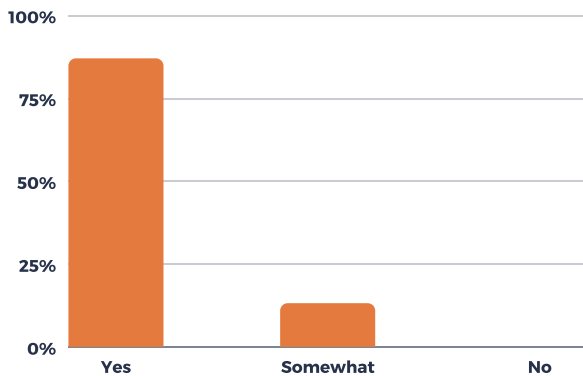

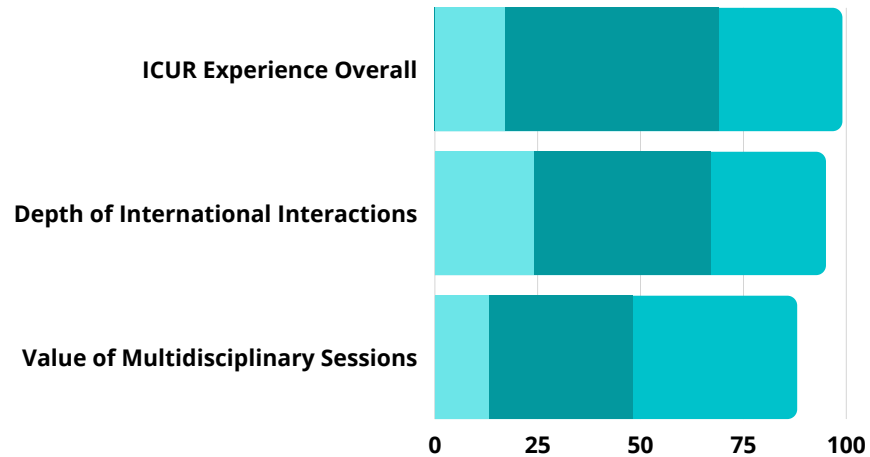
