


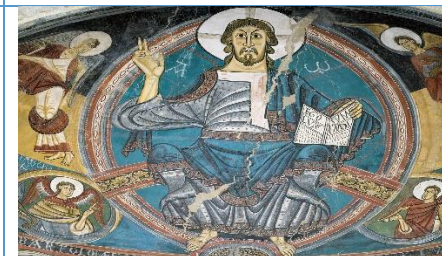
## Ongoing activities through the term
