8. Scientific Trajectory Summary (600 words)

In my research career, I have made significant methodological, empirical and theoretical contributions to studying the main determinants that explain policy-making in the EU.

Methodologically, I have made three main contributions: 1) As a researcher who has actively participated in the three phases of the design and elaboration of the DEU dataset (from 1999 to 2019). This data set includes indicators on more than 140 legislative dossiers, resulting in the most comprehensive database currently studying the EU decision-making process. The latest version of the DEU III data set has been presented in a recent publication (Arregui and Perarnaud, 2022); 2) I have created spatial models to identify the mechanisms that best explain (from a deductive perspective, i.e. through formal models) the EU policy process (Arregui et al. 2004; Arregui et al. 2006); 3) We have improved the process of reliability and validity of the data on the estimates made in the DEU dataset. This dataset is different from others (INTEREUR, DICEU or NCEU) because it implements reliability and validity tests on all data collected in Brussels. In fact, it is the only data set that checks the data provided by policy-makers against the minutes of the meetings where decisions are taken. This makes the DEU dataset a unique dataset and the most widely used in the literature.

In substantive and empirical terms, I would like to highlight the following contributions: 1) My most cited research paper (co-authored by R. Thomson and R. Torenvlied) is an article published in the British Journal of Political Science in which - for the first time - we empirically demonstrate the relationship between states' preferences (in the EU negotiation process) and states' problems in implementing the policies adopted in Brussels. Moreover, the study shows that the European Commission is a key actor in providing more or less discretion to member states. Since this article, the role of the European Commission (despite its lack of formal capacity) has been introduced in all explanatory models on the processes of (non)compliance with EU law; 2) A second relevant research paper is the article 'Shifting Policy Positions in the EU', which explains the EU negotiation process from an empirical perspective. The article, published in the European Journal of Political Research, was awarded the prize for the best article published in 2008 by the Spanish Association of Political Science and Administration (AECPA). This research shows, among other things, the importance of, as well as the fact that states are willing to compromise more on ideological issues than on issues of an economic nature; 3) Other relevant articles in my career, both in terms of the number of citations and their contribution in substantive terms, are Arregui and Thomson (2009) and Arregui (2016). These studies identify the factors that explain the success that each state obtains in the EU political process, showing that some states achieve better political and economic results than others depending on their formal (and above all informal) capabilities and other structural and agency variables.

Finally, I would like to highlight both the 2018 article (co-authored with M. Creighton) in which we show the lack of democratic legitimacy with which the EU Council acts when adopting decisions on immigration policies and the book 'Europeanization of Public Policies in Spain: Opportunities and Challenges'. It focuses on the effects that the EU governance system has had on public policies in Spain. The volume, of which I am the coordinator, touches on topics such as gender and equality policies to climate change policies, and so on. The book shows the relevance of the EU in the processes of political, economic and institutional changes and transformations from 1986 to 2021.

Through a matching between two databases: one on policy-making and the other constructed with public opinion data in the 28 member states, it shows the democratic deficit that exists in EU immigration policy-making. This is the case when there is a clear mismatch between the preferences of citizens in member states and the policies advocated and adopted by the political actors representing those states in Brussels. The DEU data set has been and is a crucial research tool in the literature when it comes to an understanding the functioning of the EU governance system in at least three respects: 1) it has helped in the verification of theories with a consistent methodological basis; 2) it has provided data that have fed into meaningful statistical analysis (quantitative analysis) and comparative cases (qualitative analysis); 3) it has facilitated rigorous analysis in peer-reviewed publications. According to Google Scholar (revised April 2022), the DEU data set has been used to date in 727 studies, 79 of these in peer-reviewed Journals in JCR (Web of Science) and 346 in Scopus (SJR). It is the most widely used dataset in the literature when analysing the main mechanisms and determinants of the EU governance system.
