## On the Rationality of Judgments of Ownership in Schizophrenia

In this paper, I consider the phenomenon of thought insertion in schizophrenia to explore the hypothesis that the corresponding first-person judgments of thought ownership are fully rational in the light of schizophrenic experience. The approach presented here provides two insights: first, judgments of ownership by schizophrenic subjects are not merely intelligible but are furthermore rationally justified given the grounds on which they are made; second, judgments of ownership by schizophrenic subjects reveal that it is rational to set apart introspective and agent-awareness grounds for the judgments and that, contrary to a family of Introspectionist views, the latter are more fundamental in determining thought ownership.
