

Job title: Research Assistant in Environmental Conflict and Politics

Job description

The pre-doctoral researcher will support Dr. Christos Zografos at the Department of Political and Social Sciences in his research on environmental transformations, conflict, and politics within the frame of his Ramon y Cajal post-doctoral fellowship. This research explores the political and power dimensions of climate change and related policies, with a particular focus on using political ecology as an analytical frame and area of knowledge contribution.

Tasks: The researcher is expected to contribute the following:

- 1. Qualitative data collection (in-depth interviews) and analysis for a case study of conflict over lithium mining in rural Portugal.
- 2. Develop one scientific article based on the analysis of the above data, which will be co-authored with Dr. Zografos
