Job title

1-year post-doctoral fellowship on ageing, care and wellbeing at the Sociology and Demography Research Group (DemoSoc) of the Pompeu Fabra University (Barcelona, Spain).

Job description

Working under the direction of Dr. Aida Solé-Auró (Universitat Pompeu Fabra) and Dr. Bruno Arpino (University of Florence), the post-doctoral fellow will undertake research on ageing, care and wellbeing using longitudinal and cross-national datasets. The selected applicant will investigate how multiple roles influence health and wellbeing of older people and the moderator effects of policies and other contextual factors. This position is linked to the multi-national research project titled "Care, Retirement & Wellbeing of Older People Across Different Welfare Regimes (CREW)". CREW is one of the projects that are funded in the second Joint Programming Initiative "More Years Better Lives". UPF (Team Leader: Bruno Arpino; UPF-PI: Aida Solé-Auró) receives funding by the Spanish Ministry of Economy, Industry and Competitiveness (MINECO Ministerio de Economía, Industria y Competitividad – AEI Agencia Estatal de Investigación). Information on the minimum requirements

We are looking for a social scientist with strong quantitative skills. The successful candidate should have substantial experience analyzing longitudinal micro-data. Preference will be given to a candidate with experience in the areas of aging/grandparenting /care / and/or with experience working with SHARE (Survey of Health and Retirement in Europe) or GGS (Generations and Gender Surveys) data. Candidates should have an excellent knowledge of English and excellent writing and social skills. Candidates must hold a PhD in Gerontology/Sociology/Demography/Economics/Statistics or allied sciences. Candidates who are expected to obtain their PhD before 31/12/ 2019 will be also considered.

Benefits of the opening

The candidate is expected to start on October 1, 2019. The position will have a duration of 1 year, with a monthly gross salary in the range of 1.800 Euros per month (plus Social Security benefits) depending on experience.

There will be no teaching obligation but teaching can be arranged, if desired by the post-doctoral fellow, including short courses organized by DemoSoc.
