Job description:

We are searching for a motivated Postdoc Researcher to participate in the project **"Involvement of the gut microbiota-brain cross talk in the loss of eating control"** which aims to evaluate the involvement of the gut microbiota-brain cross-talk and associated epigenetic changes in metabolic, behavioral and neuronal responses related to the loss of eating control. To reach this aim we will use sophisticated techniques including in vivo calcium imaging in freely moving mice during the performance of operant behavioral tasks using the miniscopes approaches proposed in this project.

The tasks and responsibilities of the post will be the following:

- Execute and analyze behavioral studies in mice animal models that combine operant conditioning paradigms with specific behavioral protocols.
- Performing stereotaxic surgeries.
- Collaboration in the analysis of the project results and elaboration of the scientific reporting, manuscript preparation
