Requirements that candidates must meet

GENERALS

- a) Be in possession of the Doctor's degree
- b) Not having been separated by means of a disciplinary file from the service of any of the public administrations, nor having been disqualified by a final judgment for the performance of public functions. In the case of being a national of another State, not being disqualified or in an equivalent situation or having been subjected to a disciplinary or equivalent sanction that prevents, in your State, in the same terms, access to public jobs.

SPECIFICS

- have dual experience in Biology and Chemistry
- have experience with redox biology systems

These participation requirements must be fulfilled on the last day of the deadline for submitting applications, they must be able to be reliably proven at any time during the selection process and they must continue to be fulfilled on the date of signing the contract.

Críteris de selecció

1. Academic Training: 0-30 points.
2. Professional experience/Adequacy to the proposed profile: 0-50 points.
3. Other merits: 0-20 points.

The minimum score to pass the selection process is: 80

Selection committee

The functioning of the selection committees will adjust to the Regulations on the remote functioning of the sessions of the collegiate bodies of the Pompeu Fabra University (Government Council Agreement of December 9, 2020), which will not hold the sessions always synchronously. If not provided for in these regulations, Law 26/2010, of August 3, on the legal and procedural regime of the public administrations of Catalonia, will apply, without prejudice to the basic norms established in article 17 of Law 40/2015 of October 1 of the legal regime of the Public Sector.

The sessions on which candidates participate will ensure the presence of the candidates and, at a minimum, the secretary of the Commission. In the event that a candidate proves his/her residency outside of Catalonia or justified circumstances prevent his/her presence, he/she may request remote participation from the Secretary of the Commission. The secretary will always be able to admit that it



does not affect the participation on equal terms between the candidates in the performance of the tests and in the evaluations that are made by the Commission.

Deadline for submitting applications

The deadline for submitting applications is 5 calendar days from the day after the publication of the call on the Pompeu Fabra University website (<https://www.upf.edu/web/biomed/job-offers>)

Submission of applications together with the supporting documentation of the merits subject to assessment

The applications must be accompanied by the supporting documentation of the qualification required and the merits subject to assessment. If copies are provided, the presentation of the corresponding original documents may be required at any time.

Requests to take part in this call must be addressed to the chancellor of Pompeu Fabra University (carrer de la Mercè, 12, 08002 Barcelona).

They can be submitted by email to the email address recruitment.melis@upf.edu, clearly indicating the position for which they are applying (MELIS-INV-INDF-2024-12), the DNI/NIE or passport number of the candidate, and with the documents signed with a digital certificate. If you do not opt for this method, it is recommended to send an email to the specified address indicating by which other method the request was submitted.

Publication of the administrative acts of this selective process

All the administrative acts of this selective procedure will be published on the Pompeu Fabra University website (<https://www.upf.edu/web/biomed/job-offers>) and this publication will have the effects of notification, of in accordance with article 45.1.b) of Law 39/2015, of October 1, on common administrative procedure of public administrations.

Once the call is made public, the publication dates of the provisional list of admitted and excluded will be made public on this same website. From the publication of the provisional list of those



admitted and excluded, a period of allegations of 2 calendar days is opened from the day after the date of publication of this provisional list.

This list will become final if no objection has been submitted after the deadline.

Against the final resolution of admitted and excluded, which exhausts the administrative route, a lawsuit may be brought before the social courts of Barcelona within two months from the day after the publication of this resolution on the University's website Pompeu Fabra.

On this same website, the approximate dates of publication of the selection committee's provision proposal and the award decision of the vice-chancellor for teaching and research staff will be made public.

Provision proposal

From the publication of the proposal for provision by the Selection Committee, a period of objections of 2 calendar days is opened from the day after the date of publication of this proposal for provision.

Award decision

The selection process will end with the awarding decision of the vice-chancellor for teaching and research staff.

Against the resolution of the vice-chancellor's allocation of teaching and research staff, a lawsuit can be brought before the social courts of Barcelona within two months from the day after the publication of this resolution on the Pompeu Fabra University website.

If you have non-EU nationality, the formalization of the contract will be subject to obtaining the corresponding residence and work authorization.

Processing of personal data

1. In accordance with the provisions of the General Data Protection Regulation, Regulation (EU) 2016/679, Pompeu Fabra University is responsible for the personal data provided, in their requests, by the people participating in the call, as well as the rest of the documentation they can provide and, if applicable, that which can be generated as a result of participation in this selection process.

2. The data will be used for the purpose of managing the selection process indicated in the general rules of the call. In other words, to carry out all the actions relating to the admission or exclusion of applicants, the attention to possible claims, the verification of the data presented by the candidates, the execution of tests and exercises and the assessment of the competition phase.

The processing of personal data will in no case include the making of automated decisions or the creation of profiles.



The personal data subject to treatment, including the image and voice, if applicable, will be kept to be able to attend to possible appeals or claims, in accordance with the deadlines established in the regulatory framework and in accordance with the applicable archive regulations.

3. The legal basis for data processing is the legal obligation. The University will treat the data in accordance with articles 77 to 86 of Organic Law 2/2023, of March 22, of the university system; articles 45 to 51 and 63 of Law 1/2003, on universities in Catalonia and the rest of applicable legislation. The data are processed within this legal obligation and to execute pre-contractual measures at the request of the person concerned.

4. Personal data will be processed by Pompeu Fabra University. Auxiliary services of information society companies with which contracts have previously been signed to preserve data privacy will be used. They may also be treated by third parties who participate in the selection process as members of the tribunal or as advisers to it, after signing a confidentiality agreement.

In compliance with the provisions of Law 39/2015, of October 1, on common administrative procedure of public administrations, and Law 19/2014, of December 29, on transparency, access to public information and good governance, the lists of candidates admitted or who pass a certain test, identified by first and last name and four digits of their DNI/NIE/Passport or Identification Document, may be published on the University's website. The list of excluded candidates or those who do not pass a certain test may be published on the University's website with identification using the four digits of their DNI/NIE/Passport or Identification Document.

The data will not be transferred to third parties without prior consent, except in the cases provided for by law.

5. Pompeu Fabra University can take photographs, capture and record the image and voice of the participants in the development of the practical tests and the interview, reproduce and use the images (photographs and/or recorded videos), free of charge, through any procedure or support, in order to be able to resolve the selective file. All this, with the sole exception and limitation of those uses or applications that could attack the right to honor in the terms provided for in Organic Law 1/1982, of May 5, on civil protection of the right to honor, personal and family privacy and self-image.
