### **Job description**

One open position for **Technician** (Group 3, 20h week/dedication) who can work independently and execute specific experiments in the Laboratory, aiming to characterize skeletal and cardiac muscle wasting during aging or disease conditions; The tasks related with this position include sample preparation from mouse skeletal and cardiac muscle, DNA extraction, genotyping (PCR) and histological techniques (OCT cryosection and immunostaining).
