Research Assistant position funded by a Fundació BBVA grant

Job description

For a Fundació BBVA project led by UPF Professor Daniel Navarro, we are looking for two students/recent graduates interested in gaining experience in academic research in the fields of negotiation and organizational behaviour, to work as Research Assistants for Prof. Jordi Quoidbach (<https://www.quoidbach.org/>).

Under Professor Quoidbach's supervision, the chosen candidates will be responsible for coding transcripts of dyadic negotiation conversations. RAs will demonstrate attention to details, accountability, flexibility/adaptability and judgment/problem solving while fulfilling job duties.

Minimum requirements

- Excellent knowledge in both oral and written English;
- High level of attention to details, including time-management, planning;
- Problem solving skills;
- Basic knowledge of Excel software.

Type of contract: Personal de Suport a la Recerca (PSR)

Job status: part time, 10 hours/week

Work location: UPF Ciutadella Campus, Barcelona. Remote work is allowed two days a week.

Remuneration: 960.12 euros gross.
