Job title

Research Assistant position funded by a Fundación BBVA grant

Job description

A research assistant position is available for circa one month within the Fundación BBVA project G999088Q led by UPF Professor Daniel Navarro (http://danielnavarromartinez.net/).

Under Professor Navarro's supervision, and also as requested by UPF team members Professor Gaël Le Mens (https://sites.google.com/view/gael-le-mens/home) and Professor Mikhail Spektor (https://msspektor.github.io/), the chosen candidate will perform the following tasks:

- 1. Carry out analyses of retweet data to measure how politicians give feedback to each other.
- 2. Programme studies on the collective behaviour implications of feedback provision mechanisms.
- 3. Analyse experimental data on feedback giving and feedback interpretation.

Candidate profile

- 1. Computational skills: The ideal candidate would have a strong programming background. Experience working with R, MATLAB, and Stata are a must.
- 2. Sound knowledge of data analysis, econometrics, and social media (Twitter in particular).
- 3. Educational background: A master's degree in Data Science, Computational Social Sciences/Economics, Economics, or related fields.

Dates and remuneration

The work is expected to be performed over a month (ca. 120 hours) before the end of 2021, but a longer deadline might be agreed with the chosen candidate.

Remuneration is 25 EUR/hour to be paid upon submission of an invoice.
