## Description

The Center for Research in Occupational Health (CiSAL) in Pompeu Fabra University (UPF) invites applications for a research position in biostatistics and epidemiology. The position will start between September  $22^{nd}$  and October  $1^{st}$ , 2015. We seek individuals with specialization in the application and development of biostatistics methods in public and occupational health.

The candidate will be involved as a team member in the following lines of research: 1) occupational health, especially sickness absence, 2) surveys of working conditions and health, 3) occupational safety and health policies, and 4) occupational health inequalities. Candidates must have a doctoral degree (e.g., PhD) in epidemiology, statistics or equivalent degree. The successful applicant will be expected to engage in teaching in both our undergraduate and master's programs in occupational health and public health, and to mentor graduate students. Teaching and research experience, including excellent publication record, will be relevant for the position. Previous experience is especially valued in advanced knowledge of statistical packages (Stata, R, SPSS, and SAS), and multilevel and longitudinal designs and analyses including latent growth trajectory analysis. Fluency in both English and Spanish is required; knowledge of Catalan is preferred.

The Center for Research in Occupational Health (CiSAL) is part of the Department of Experimental and Health Sciences in UPF and located in Barcelona (Spain). CiSAL seeks to become a center of excellence, recognized academically, professionally and socially for the generation and transfer of useful knowledge to improve the health of workers.
