Job description

The Research Technician will work on a project funded by the Barcelona City Council's Barcelona Science Program (*Barcelona Ciència*) aimed at Strengthening Barcelona's Defenses Against Disease-Vector Mosquitoes (ref. 19S01587-006). The technician will be responsible for scientific communication, outreach and community management. Tasks will include recruitment of a group of volunteer citizen scientists who will be involved in calibrating a large, community-driven system for detecting disease-vector mosquitos.

This is a fulltime position starting on 1 March 2020 and lasting less than one year. The position is in Research Support Personnel category 1 (*Tècnic sup. de suport a la recerca*). The annual base salary is 33,120.88 euros.
