Research assistant on social mobility analysis at the DEMOSOC Research Group of the Pompeu Fabra University (Barcelona, Spain).

Job description

The project's purpose is to analyze the impact of the 2007-11 recession on mobility chances in Europe. The candidate is expected to help in the preparation and analysis of the data to be used in the research (2005 and 2011 EU-SILC surveys) and to contribute to a bibliographic review about the topic.

Information on the minimum requirements

Candidates must hold a Degree in Social Sciences and oral and written fluency in English. They must have a solid statistical background and familiarity with the EU-SILC and GGS surveys. Candidates should have very good programming skills in Stata, including knowledge of merging procedures to create single files from multiple sources, and of weighting procedures for dealing with complex sampling designs. Knowledge of techniques and models for the analyses of mobility tables would be an asset.
