

Degree in Global Studies Syllabus

Workload

240 credits ECTS

Basic training: 60 ECTS credits

Compulsory: 70 ECTS credits

Optional: 90 ECTS credits (minimum 16 ECTS Global Orientation Module. Includes External Internships of 4 to 20 ECTS credits. Includes compulsory Mobility minimum

of 20 ECTS credits on account of elective credits)

Final Year Project: 20 ECTS credits

The degree in Global Studies syllabus is organized according to basic and compulsory subjects from the first to fourth years and according to optional subjects in the third and fourth year.

In the third year there will be a compulsory stay in other university, where the student will take a minimum of 20 credits (included in the optional credits).

The fourth year includes the final year project (20 credits) and the external placement/internship (up to 20 optional credits, included in the credits of the optional subjects).

The basic and compulsory subjects will have 6 credits each, with the exception of Project Design and Management (4 ECTS), while the optional ones will have from 4 to 6 credits. At least 16 of the credits of the optional subjects taken by the student should be in Module 2 – Optional global approach subjects.

Language training includes three compulsory subjects in a foreign language: Spanish and Catalan (only for international students), Chinese, Arabic, Russian, French choose to complete 18 credits.
