Job description Research Support Website Technician

The Research Support Website Technician is responsible for the maintenance and updating of the academic website, "PREDMED," which was created with the dual functions of a research hub and academic social network for the participant members and collaborators of the research project, "RETRAGENMED," and a searchable data base of primary and secondary sources on medieval Christian, Jewish, and Muslim preaching and sermons for the international scientific community.

Specific roles and responsibilities. Maintenance and updating of the website: project-related news, bibliographic novelties, relevant scientific activities; Moderating and coordinating digital fora; Liaising with members of the PREDMED network; Administration of academic social networking of network members and collaborators (CEO); Support in organizing scientific activities (conferences, workshops, etc.) Updating data and labels for website preaching/sermons search engine using the TEI/XML system; Implementation of system for editing sermon manuscripts online; Monitoring, evaluation, and improvement of the website as needed; Optimization of the positioning of the website in Internet searches (SEO).

The ideal candidate should combine optimal technical skills—s/he should be highly skilled in computing and information technology, website design and maintenance; creation, maintenance, and administration of data bases and search engines; administration of academic messaging and social networks; and handling of digital texts and images—with a solid foundation in the Humanities and Medieval History in particular, given the nature of the data under study.
