CALL FOR APPLICATIONS: ERASMUS+ MOBILITY CIEL EXCHANGE PROGRAM FOR THE 2021-2022 ACADEMIC YEAR

The UPF Law Department offers MACJ and MEGL students 6 places to study, from September 2021, in the Universities part of the CIEL Exchange Program: University of Mannheim, University of Antwerp, University College Dublin, Maastricht University, Toulouse Capitole University, Zagreb University.

In the current global context where physical mobility may be compromised according to the evolution of the health situation in each country, the UPF Law Department reaffirms its commitment with the academic recognition of the courses followed face to face, remote or blended. It is the competence of each university to decide the modality of teaching that will be offered at the beginning of the academic year.

1. Requisites for participating in the call

This exchange call is aimed at students enrolled in the Máster Avanzado en Ciencias Jurídicas and the Master in European and Global Law, during the 2019-2020 or 2020-2021 academic year at Universitat Pompeu Fabra.

The Erasmus+ only supports students which comply and want to pursue the CIEL Exchange Program. As a general criterion, students who follow the courses online and without displacement to the university of destination will not benefit from the Erasmus+ scholarship.

After a public competitive call, the selection is decided by the Coordinators of the Máster Avanzado en Ciencias Jurídicas and the Master in European and Global Law.

Students must comply with the academic requirements of the CIEL Exchange Program: they must spend at least one semester at the host university, they must take 30 ECTS worth of courses offered at the Master Level. The Master's Thesis will be enrolled at the Universitat Pompeu Fabra and its credits are not considered as part of these 30 ECTS credits. For the Master's Thesis students must find a second supervisor at the host university, apart from the first supervisor at UPF. The breach of this academic conditions will imply the revocation of the grant. Once selected, candidates must present a feasible Learning Agreement detailing the subjects to be done at the host university and their equivalence in the academic programs of the Máster Avanzado en Ciencias Jurídicas and the Master in European and Global Law.

Only students with a C.1 of English (a minimum of 6.5 in the IELTS with a minimum of 6 in writing or a minimum of 90 TOEFL) are eligible to this call, apart from students having English as the mother tongue. These requirements are not applicable for the places at University of Mannheim and Toulouse Capitole University.

Students who are already beneficiaries of one of the grants offered by the Department of Law or the Universitat Pompeu Fabra cannot apply to this call.

2. Selection criteria

Students will be selected according to three criteria: (1) the CV before the enrollment to the Máster Avanzado en Ciencias Jurídicas or Master in European and Global Law; (2) letter of motivation; and (3) the fulfillment of the language requirements.

In particular, it will be necessary to consider the situation of students with special needs and high level athletes who participate in the call, when giving them access to places adapted to their personal and professional situation, with their condition properly accredited and motivated need.

3. Application

Applicants must fill in the form attached to this call and deliver it to the Secretary of the Department of Law by 27 November 2020. They must attach to the form: (1) a CV stating the academic and professional background before the enrollment to Máster Avanzado en Ciencias Jurídicas or Master in European and Global Law; and (2) an official certificate -or equivalent-accrediting the language requirements of this Call. The Letter of motivation is included in the form (2000 words approximately).

4. Resolution

The places will be allocated by the Coordinators of the Máster Avanzado en Ciencias Jurídicas and the Master in European and Global Law.


