- Workplace: remote (but you must be available to come to UPF when necessary to support face-to-face tasks, training seminars, activities at the centre, etc.)
- Work hours: 360 hours. From approximately November of 2024 to May 2025.

Tasks:

The student, under the supervision of the internship tutor, will participate in the following tasks of the study centre:

- Participate in research tasks of the projects and academic activities of the centre and its members.
- Participate in the drafting and preparation of materials for strategic campaigns of the centre and in the tasks of execution of the campaigns.
- Participate in the organization of events and events.
- All tasks will be related and provide skills:
- Transversal and basic: teamwork, responsibility, autonomy, interpersonal relationship, willingness to learn
- Generic texts from different disciplines: mainly strategic communication, political philosophy and ethics
- Specific: relating to animal ethics, critical animal studies and animal activism.

Other candidate requirements:

- They must be enrolled in the MA in International Studies in Media, Power and Difference at UPF (full or part time).
- With their academic record and curriculum vitae, they must also provide a letter of motivation of maximum 500 words) to explain why the candidate considers that their profile is suitable for these internships and why they want to do an internship at UPF-Centre for Animal Ethics.

You must have a very good level of English (Spanish and Catalan are welcomed but not compulsory)
