

Malcolm Fairbrother is Professor of Sociology at Umeå University, and a researcher at the Institute for Futures Studies, in Stockholm, Sweden. Originally from Canada, he holds a PhD in sociology from the University of California, Berkeley (USA). He worked in England for ten years, and has been a visiting researcher at institutions in Mexico, Spain, and Italy. His methodological research has concentrated on the use of multilevel models in analysing comparative survey data. In his substantive research, he studies social trust, political trust, and

public attitudes towards environmental degradation and protection. He has also used qualitative comparative-historical methods to investigate the political origins of economic globalization. His work has appeared in journals such as the *European Sociological Review*, *American Journal of Sociology*, *Political Science Research and Methods*, and the *British Journal of Political Science*.
