

"New Developments in Survey Methodology" Course Series

Course 1: "Attitudes and their measurement using subjective reference points"

Date: October 27-28, 2010, from 11h00-13h00 and 14h30-17h30.

Place: Universitat Pompeu Fabra. Edifici Roger de Llúria, room 40.035. Carrer de Ramón Trias Fargas 25-27 (metro Ciutadella - Villa Olímpica). Barcelona, Spain.

The course will be taught by **Prof. Dr. Ákos Münnich**, Director of the Institute of Psychology and Head of the Department of Social and Work Psychology of the University of Debrecen, Hungary.

Short description of the course:

It is widely accepted that attitudes are best defined as overall evaluations of objects. Recently it has also become accepted that evaluations are comparative in nature, and relative to norms or standards (reference points). During the course we will go through the steps to develop models fulfilling some general requirements of subjective evaluation.

The course consists of four parts. First, we briefly discuss several issues regarding the role, structure, function, strength, ambivalence, etc. of attitudes. Second, we discuss some measurement problems of measuring attitudes (including implicit attitudes). Third, issues regarding relative subjective evaluations and aggregations of evaluations will be discussed, and a new model of subjective evaluations (which includes reference points) and a technique for measuring attitudes will be presented. Finally, in order to complete the understanding of the new model, a short introduction to functional equations will be given, which plays a role in developing the attitude model discussed in the course.

During the course, several examples and experiments will be presented. The estimation of the model parameters can easily be done by the program Mathematica® (especially its adds-on module Global Optimization®), and this will be illustrated throughout the course.
