1. PREAMBLE: Why, when where...registration

Why should I do it?



- 1 Fun!...when you like studying and research.....
- 2 Neither long nor short! 3 years!!!
 Registration is necessary every year
- 3 Cheap!... € 401,12/year!!! Cheaper than a Master's (and perhaps this changes...so better catch the opportunity)
 - **Total fees** € 401,12 x 3 = 1,203.36 + 70 € taxes
- 4 Higher level in academia!! Third cycle (Master's = Second cycle): I+D+i
- 5 A plus in many job positions, a requirement in some (certainly in academia)

When should I do it?



- YES!!! Right after your Master's Degree (with a research strand)...
 - You will not be required to follow any extra courses besides some Seminars, if you have graduated in one of our Departmental Masters' (MLTA; Mtranslation; Mdiscourse; Mcognitive Sciences)
 - You have everything fresh in your head, and you will be able to catch the momentum!!
 - It is a very good option if you still have not got a job...
 - AND also if you do have a job, because in that case, you can apply to do it part-time
 ...


- >PRE-REGISTRATION: 2 periods before the summer

- **▶ REGISTRATION:** 1st-5th October BE STRICT with DEADLINES for ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES:
 - > APPLYING FOR AN EXTENSION, INTERRUPTION. Fixed dates.



Academic Requirements at pre-registration




- Degree certificate (Spanish 240 ECTS/Foreign 300 ECTS)

- Master's academic report
- 1 Statement of interest and past achievements
- 1 Future Research Project
- **2** Endorsing reference letters
- 1 Endorsing letter issued by a contact teacher at our Department (ideally your future PhD director)



Defence, assessment and prizes



- Diposit: 2 months prior to...
- Your PhD DEFENCE
- Presentation and discussion of your work:
 - PUBLIC defence
 - 30-40 minutes presentation+ questions from committee & answer time
- COMMITTEE: 3 EXPERTS (not your PhD director)
- Evaluation: Numerical (5-10; 10+ Cum Laude)
- Prize EXTRAORDINARY mention: Granted among 10+ PhDs
- INTERNATIONAL mention (3 month stay at a foreign university+ 2 international experts on your committee + 2 languages used during the defence)
