CALL FOR APPLICATIONS: ERASMUS+ MOBILITY CIEL EXCHANGE PROGRAM FOR THE 2020-2021 ACADEMIC YEAR

The Department of Law offers 4 Erasmus+ exchange places to study in the Universities part of the CIEL Exchange Program: University of Mannheim, University of Antwerp, University College Dublin, Maastricht University, Toulouse Capitole University, Zagreb University.

1. Requisites for participating in the call

This exchange call is aimed at students enrolled in the Master Avanzado en Ciencias Jurídicas and the Master in European and Global Law, during the 2020-2021 academic year at Universitat Pompeu Fabra.

The Erasmus+ places only support students which comply and want to pursue the CIEL Exchange Program. After a public competitive call, the selection is decided by the Coordinators of the Master Avanzado en Ciencias Jurídicas and the Master in European and Global Law.

The students must comply with the academic requirements of the CIEL Exchange Program: they must spend at least one semester at the host university, they must take 30 ECTS worth of courses offered at the Master Level. The Final Master Thesis will be enrolled at the Universitat Pompeu Fabra and its credits are not considered as part of these 30 ECTS credits. For the Final Master Thesis students must find a second supervisor at the host university, apart from the first supervisor at UPF. The breach of this academic conditions will imply the revocation of the grant. At the moment of the application, the candidates must present a feasible Learning Agreement detailing the subjects to be done in the host university and their equivalence in the academic programs of the Master Avanzado en Ciencias Jurídicas and the Master in European and Global Law.

Only students with a C.1 of English (a minimum of 6,5 in the IELTS with a minimum of 6 in writing or a minimum of 90 TOEFL) are eligible to this call. These requirements are not applicable for the places at University of Mannheim and Toulouse Capitole University.

Students who are already beneficiaries of one of the grants offered by the Department of Law or the Universitat Pompeu Fabra can not apply to this call.

2. Selection criteria

The students will be selected according to three criteria: (1) the CV before the enrollment; (2) letter of motivation; (3) and the fulfillment of the language requirements.

3. Application

Applicants must fill the form attached to this call and deliver it to the Secretary of the Department of Law by 15 November 2019. They must attach to the form: (1) a CV for providing academic and professional background before the enrollment to the Masters programme, and (2) an official certificate –or equivalent- proving the language requirement of this Call. The letter of motivation is included in the form (2000 word approximately).

4. Resolution

The places will be allocated by the Coordinators of the Master Avanzado en Ciencias Jurídicas and the Master in European and Global Law.

The resolution of this call will be published as of the 22 November 2019 and will be notified directly by email to the applicants. Once selected, the applicants should present a proposal of Learning Agreement to the Law School Mobility Coordinator not late than 9 December 2019.
