PERSONAL DATA PROTECTION

Purpose: To process, verify and justify the aid. Personal data will be stored for as long as needed to process, verify and justify the aid and to determine any legal liability to which it might give rise. The terms of the regulations on archiving and documents will apply.

The processing may involve collection and access to **special categories of data**, such as data revealing racial or ethnic origin, political opinions, religious or philosophical beliefs, or trade union membership, data concerning health, or data concerning a natural person's sex life or sexual orientation.

Lawful basis: The public interest mission established, amongst others, under Spanish Organic Law 6/2001, of 21 December 2001, on universities and the applicant's consent, including explicit consent for the processing of special categories of data needed for the award of the aid.

Recipient: Pompeu Fabra University. Data will not be disclosed to third parties unless there is a legal obligation to do so.
