Greening Consumer Welfare: Towards a new perspective on consumer protection

The conference will focus – among others - on the legal analysis of consumer protection through the lens of sustainability and climate crisis concerns. The conference welcomes contributions on any topic related to the redefinition of consumer protection regulation under environmental and social sustainability concerns from an experimental, empirical, economic, or purely normative perspectives.



The Workshop will focus – among others - on the impact of artificial intelligence, digitalization processes, data centers and platform consumption on sustainability goals and climate crisis concerns. We want to bring together multiple disciplinary perspectives on these issues, including political and social sciences, law, economics and ecology. These activities will harness ongoing research by faculty and graduate students and help to link them with wider academic networks.





Submissions for the Conference and/or Workshop should be sent as a final paper (including an abstract of 200 words) or as an outline of minimum 2 pages to **planet@upf.edu** until **August 1**st **2022**. Submissions by women and underrepresented minorities are particularly welcome.

Limited financial aid is available for few invited speakers and for selected papers presented by PhD candidates. The International Conference and the Workshop will take place jointly and participants are welcome to submit for one of the events and participate in both.

Communication of acceptance will be by **August 10th**, **2022** and final papers are due on **September 1st 2022**.

Selected communications may be published in a special issue of an indexed journal or as a book chapter (information will be provided in due course).
