Dr. Óscar J. Martín García has a permanent position as Senior Scientists at INGENIO (CSIC-Universitat Politècnica de València). He has previously been a researcher at the Aarhus Institute of Advanced Studies (Marie Curie COFUND Program, 2015-2017), the University of La Laguna (Viera y Clavijo Program, 2017-2018) and the Complutense University of Madrid (2018-2021). In recent years, his research has focused on the fields of international history and foreign relations. He has specialized on the inquiry of the United States' cultural, educational and scientific diplomacy toward Franco's Spain between the 1950s and 1970s. His work has also delved into the field of international development and Cold war modernization. He is currently principal investigator of a project on U.S. postwar space diplomacy and is interested in studying the Fulbright program of academic exchanges from a transnational perspective.
