

Group Leader Position in Economics Serra Hùnter Distinguished Professor Universitat Pompeu Fabra Barcelona, Spain

The Department of Economics and Business of the Universitat Pompeu Fabra (UPF) aims to fill a Group Leader position in the field of Economics. We are looking for candidates with an excellent track record in **economic theory, with particular emphasis on decision theory, behavioral economics, and microeconomic theory**, and an interest in the theoretical foundations of economic behavior under uncertainty, learning, and information.

Candidates' current affiliation must be in a country different from Spain, and they must have broad research and teaching experience in international centers, as well as leadership skills.

Successful candidates will be highly accomplished scientists with a PhD in Economics (or a closely related field), and a strong capacity to lead high-impact research projects. The future group leader will be expected to attract national and international research funds. The selected candidate will actively engage in teaching in both undergraduate and graduate UPF programs. In particular, in courses such as **Microeconomics, Game Theory, Behavioral Decision Theory and Behavioral Economics**. The selected applicant will also supervise doctoral theses and will be expected to collaborate with the other research groups of the Department, including those working in microeconomic theory and behavioral economics, in scientific interdisciplinary projects of common interest. A focus on knowledge transfer activities will be positively evaluated. Experience in developing theoretical models of **choice under uncertainty, stochastic or random choice, and dynamic learning processes**, or in connecting theory with experimental or behavioral evidence, will be positively valued.

The Department of Economics and Business at UPF

The main goal of the UPF Department of Economics and Business is to promote high quality research. It is expected that its faculty members publish in leading international journals, and both hiring and promotion depend crucially on the publishing record. The long track record of publications and forthcoming papers is the reflection of the importance that the Department places on high quality research .

The Department includes three research centres: BESLab: Behavioral Sciences Laboratory (Experimental Economics), CRES (Health Economics) and BARG (Business Analytics Research Group), it has close connections with CREI (Macro and International Economics) and is part of the Barcelona School of Economics, as well as of IPEG (Institute of Political Economy and Governance).

The Department is one of the highest ranked Economics Departments in Europe. It combines strong research across macroeconomics, international economics, finance, microeconomics, management, health economics, and data science, and has developed particular strengths in empirical and interdisciplinary research.

Research at the Department of Economics and Business

The Department conducts teaching and research in Economics, Management, Data Science and related fields. Its research strategy aims to build on its strengths across core areas such as macroeconomics, microeconomics, finance, development, economic history, and applied empirical methods. It seeks to attract researchers who can contribute to these areas while also fostering synergies across disciplines, particularly in topics that combine **formal theoretical modeling with behavioral and experimental approaches**, and the study of economic decision-making under uncertainty, information, and learning.

The Department brings together research across a wide range of fields, including microeconomics, macroeconomics, finance, economic history, and data science. The interaction across these areas fosters a highly collaborative environment and has been key to the Department's development as a leading research centre in Europe.

3. **List of 5 selected publications**, with a brief description of each of them.

4. **Brief proposal of future research plans at the Department** (maximum 2 pages).

5. **Contact details of 3 referees** (name, affiliation, and email address) in a single document.
