

Following the evaluation of the final PhD candidates by the PhD Selection Committee of the Department, the Dorcas Muthoni Selection Committee and the Teaching Commission of the Department of Engineering in February 2026, we are pleased to inform you about the results.

After being accepted to the PhD program, the assessment of the records of candidates and in accordance with the selection criteria published in the call, according to the assessment of the 5 members of the evaluation committee, it was agreed to grant the Dorcas Muthoni PhD Fellowship (predoctoral researcher contract - PRC) for the academic year 2026-27 to the following candidate:

Substitute reserve candidates will be the following:

1. **Salamatu MUSA**, with the support of Dr. Davina Hernández-Leo.

The awarded candidate will have a Full PhD (PIPF1) fellowship:

-Full PhD (PIPF1): Includes teaching assistant tasks (45 hours). Minimum monthly Gross Salary 1.515€ for the first and second years, a gross monthly salary of 1.623€ for the third year, and 2.029 € for the fourth year*

Non-EU students will have a reduction of 24 % in the first three months (till December, if the contract starts in October). The corresponding taxes will be deducted from January when the new fiscal year starts. () These amounts correspond to the wages of 2025.*
