



CORRECTION OF MATERIAL ERROR: 2025-2027 ERASMUS+ *International Credit Mobility Programme Call for applications for outgoing Staff & Postgraduate Student mobility between UPF and Non-European partner universities*

Following the publication of the guidelines and the resolution of the first round of the 2025-2027 call for Erasmus+ international mobility grants for staff and outgoing postgraduate students between UPF and non-European partner universities of the project 2024-1-ES01-KA171-HED-000240210, a material error has been identified regarding the eligibility criteria in one of the announced places.

Consequently, we proceed to rectify the publication of the guidelines and amend it with immediate effect, in accordance with the applicable eligibility regulations (referenced in the Erasmus+ Programme Guide 2024, page 71 Spanish version), for which the following modifications proceed:

Item in the Guidelines	Correction
Point 4 (Eligibility Conditions)	The condition is modified to clarify the non-eligibility of the Master's student level for outgoing students for certain places according to Erasmus+ regulations.
Annex 2, Asia Region (Beijing Language and Culture University - BLCU)	In the offer spot, where it stated "1 Master", becomes "1 PhD" (Doctorate).

As a consequence of these modifications, it is also amended the award resolution by which the scholarship awarded to outgoing Master's mobility at Beijing Language and Culture University to student Jane April Haydon Jones (ID Z-1828910-R), is transferred to project 2024-1-ES01-KA131-HED-000224044, given that within this mentioned project her mobility is eligible and there are available funds.

Against this resolution, which exhausts the administrative route, an administrative litigation appeal may be filed before the administrative litigation court of Barcelona within two months starting from the day after its publication. Interested parties may also optionally file an appeal for reversal before the same body that issued the resolution within one month starting from the day after its publication; in this case, an administrative litigation appeal cannot be filed until the appeal for reversal has been expressly resolved or dismissed by administrative silence.
