CALL FOR APPLICATIONS: ERASMUS+ MOBILITY CIEL EXCHANGE PROGRAM FOR THE 2026-2027 ACADEMIC YEAR

The UPF Law Department offers MACJ and MEGL students 6 places to study, from September 2026, in the Universities part of the CIEL Exchange Program: University of Mannheim, University of Antwerp, Maastricht University, Toulouse Capitole University, Zagreb University.

1. Requisites for participating in the call

This exchange call is aimed at students enrolled in the Máster Universitario en Ciencias Jurídicas Avanzadas and the Master in European and Global Law, during the 2025-2026 and 2026-2027 academic year at Universitat Pompeu Fabra.

The Erasmus+ only supports students who comply and want to pursue the CIEL Exchange Program. As a general criterion, students who follow the courses online and without displacement to the university of destination will not benefit from the Erasmus+ scholarship.

After a public competitive call, the selection is decided by the Coordinators of the Máster Universitario en Ciencias Jurídicas Avanzadas and the Master in European and Global Law.

Students must comply with the academic requirements of the CIEL Exchange Program: they must spend at least one semester at the host university, they must take 24 ECTS worth of courses offered at the Master Level. The Master's Thesis will be enrolled at the Universitat Pompeu Fabra and its credits are not considered as part of these 24 ECTS credits. For the Master's Thesis students must find a second supervisor at the host university, apart from the first supervisor at UPF. The breach of these academic conditions will imply the revocation of the grant. Once selected, candidates must present a feasible Learning Agreement detailing the subjects to be done at the host university and their equivalence in the academic programs of the Máster Universitario en Ciencias Jurídicas Avanzadas and the Master in European and Global Law.

Only students with a C.1 of English (a minimum of 6.5 in the IELTS with a minimum of 6 in writing or a minimum of 90 TOEFL) are eligible to this call, apart from students having English as the mother tongue or students who have studied Bachelor degree in English. These requirements are not applicable for the places at University of Mannheim and Toulouse Capitole University.

Students who are already beneficiaries of one of the grants offered by the Department of Law or the Universitat Pompeu Fabra cannot apply to this call.

2. Selection criteria

Students will be selected according to three criteria: (1) the CV before the enrollment to the Máster Universitario en Ciencias Jurídicas Avanzadas or Master in European and Global Law; (2) letter of motivation; and (3) the fulfillment of the language requirements.

In particular, it will be necessary to consider the situation of students with special needs and high-level athletes who participate in the call, when giving them access to places adapted to their personal and professional situation, with their condition properly accredited and motivated.

3. Application

Applicants must fill in the form attached to this call and deliver it to the Secretary of the Department of Law by 11 December 2025. They must attach to the form: (1) a CV stating the academic and professional background before the enrollment to Máster Universitario en Ciencias Jurídicas Avanzadas or Master in European and Global Law; and (2) an official certificate or equivalent accrediting the language requirements of this Call. The Letter of motivation is included in the form (2000 words approximately).

4. Resolution

The places will be allocated by the Coordinators of the Máster Universitario en Ciencias Jurídicas Avanzadas and the Master in European and Global Law.

The resolution of this call will be published as of 18 December 2025 and will be notified directly by email to the applicants. Once selected, the applicants should submit a proposal of Learning Agreement to the Law School Mobility Coordinator (monica.vinaixa@upf.edu) no later than 15 June 2026.
