

Call for position: Research Assistant in Psychology, Psychiatry & Linguistics

Description

The selected person will join the Grammar & Cognition (GraC) research group at Universitat Pompeu Fabra (UPF) in the frame of Synergy grant awarded to Dr. Wolfram Hinzen and three co-PIs by the European Research Council. The aim of the grant is to understand language changes in psychosis and their underlying neural basis, with the ultimate aim of predicting relapse. The candidate will work as liaison between the UPF and clinical partners, specifically the Centres Assistencials Emili Mira (CAEM), which is part of the Hospital del Mar Healthcare System (Parc de Salut Mar).

Tasks to be performed

Tasks will include coordinating the implementation, patient assessment and monitoring of participation in a ground-breaking study aimed at both improving the mechanistic understanding of language metrics related to psychosis and identifying changes in the expression and structure of language that could serve as a warning signal of an impending clinical worsening.

- Training in Mental Health Research, General Health Psychology, PIR, MIR and/or linguistics, as well as master's/doctorate in a related field is valued.
